

## Crider To Visit ND

When [Markus Crider](#) makes his visit to Notre Dame the weekend of Sept. 19th, the 6-foot-6, 195-pound wing player from Wayne High, hopes to bring back something definite to his Huber Heights, Ohio home.

“Coach (Anthony) Solomon told my mom they’re going to offer me when I go up there.”

The Irish assistant coach has also been keeping in regular touch with Crider himself. The two talk regularly, and Crider remembers seeing Notre Dame at nearly everyone of his AAU games over the summer.

“He says he’s recruiting me for more than one position,” Crider said. ESPN ranks him as the 24th best SF in the junior class. “He likes the whole aspect that I can contribute in every aspect of the basketball game.

“Notre Dame is a great school. I think I would fit in well with them. I’m still learning more about Notre Dame everyday, but it’s a nice school, great players and it’d be nice going there.”

Crider already holds scholarship offers from Akron, Dayton, Wright State and Ohio. Besides the Irish, he’s also hearing from Illinois, Michigan, Xavier and DePaul.

Last fall, Crider and his dad took a visit to Notre Dame, the weekend the football team hosted Pittsburgh. He will return in a couple weeks with both of his parents for the Michigan State game.

“I want to see more of the basketball facilities and academic facilities.”

Crider plans to see a lot of other schools this fall, and says he’s nowhere near listing favorites.

“I’ll probably make my decision senior year. I’m looking for something that is up tempo, likes to run, and that’s a nice physical basketball team.”

Crider’s mother also told him that Solomon said something else.

“She said that they don’t really jump the gun on offers. I’m excited.”
