

Wayne, Jefferson post Classic wins

Travis Trice scored a game-high 22 points and Wayne blitzed Massillon Jackson 62-53 in the 8th Annual Scholastic Play-by-Play Classic at Ohio State University's Schottenstein Center on Saturday, Jan. 23.

The Warriors, the DDN's top-ranked Division I team, improved to 11-2. Jackson fell to 11-2.

Jefferson 66, Harvest Prep 56: Adreian Payne had 21 points, 18 rebounds, five assists and three blocks as the Broncos overcame an early 13-point deficit in the opening game of the Play-by-Play Classic. Devin Foster added 19 points and Joby Jackson 11 for Jefferson.

Carroll 43, Alter 34: Trez Jones scored 18 points and was 8-for-14 from the line to lead Carroll.

Alex Miller led Oakwood with 14 points. Clair Davis scored 12 points and was 6-for-8 from the free-throw line. The win was the sixth in a row for Waynesville (11-3).
