

## DDN boys basketball poll for Feb. 12

### Division I

---

**1. Wayne (13-2):** The word of the week is DNP, as in did not play. That's just what the Warriors didn't do — along with most other ranked teams — this past week because of the slip-and-slide winter weather. Should Wayne take care of host Northmont today and visiting Centerville on Saturday, the Warriors will be rewarded with a No. 1 sectional seed Sunday at WSU.

**2. Trotwood-Madison (12-3):** Rams have won three straight, including a 72-56 throttling of Jefferson and big man Adreian Payne. No word yet on a possible dream match vs. Wayne. A postseason showdown will suffice.

**3. Springfield (12-3, dnp):** Wildcats jump up a spot because Butler had the misfortune to drop its only game. Rematches with Wayne and Northmont — both of whom beat Springfield — eventually loom.

**4. Troy (10-4, dnp):** Trojans also advance a spot. A couple of rescheduled games remain, including a date with Trotwood.

**3. Vandalia Butler (11-5):** Aviators were hammered 71-49 — and A.J. Pacher was shut down — by Spg. Shawnee to snap a five-game win streak.
